



Caribbean Integration Programme Bursaries 2010/2011

Programme Overview

The Caribbean Integration Programme was conceived in 2006, with a view of promoting the movement of students across the four campuses of the UWI – thereby re-kindling the spirit of regional integration that had characterized the University in its early days of existence.

In the academic year 2010/2011, we hope to award ten (10) bursaries valued at US\$ 5,000 each for students desirous of spending one semester at a campus other than their home campus. Recipients of the bursaries would use the US\$ 5,000 to cover expenses associated with airfare; accommodation and upkeep while at their Residence; and would also have an appropriate cultural Programme in place.

Eligibility:

The bursary is available to registered, full time undergraduate students who:

- have completed two (2) semesters of study at their respective campuses;
- are not entering their final semester
- are not pursuing a degree Programme in the faculties of Law, Engineering or Medicine.

Criteria

The award will be based on:

- good academic performance (a minimum GPA of 3.0) in the previous year's University Examinations;
- Verifiable involvement in co-curricular activities.

How to Apply

- Applications are available from the Campus International Office located at each campus;
- Complete application form in full, as incomplete application will not be processed;
- Application forms should be accompanied by proof of the specific course(s) which you intend to study for the semester(s). These courses should be approved by both home and host Faculty/Department;

The completed application form and other required /support documents should be submitted to The Registry on the Cave Hill and ST Augustine Campus or the International Students Office at the Mona Campus. Applications will not be accepted after March 1, 2010.
