# Teaching Achievement

The Department scored an overall mean of 3.9 in both semesters for lecturer preparation, knowledge of subject area, punctuality and accessibility. The average course rating score was 3.6, with 66% of all courses having a score above 3.5. Average student response rate was 50%.

### Graduate Training:

Student enrolment in the Department's MSc Economics programme totalled fifty-two for the academic year, while there were seven graduate students in the International Law programme taught jointly with the Department of Government. Five Students completed the M.Sc Economics programme during the year.
